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

RAILING INSTRUCTIONS FOR WOOD SLEEVING

Any galvanized component, if cut or marred, must be regalvanized to prevent rusting. All fasteners must meet local code requirements.


Step 1

Securely mount 4x4 treated wood posts to facial rimboard of deck on 6' or 8'centers. Make sure posts are plumb and secure. On 36" railing - wood posts should be 37" above deck. On 42" railing – wood posts should be 43" above deck. Check with local code officials for proper 4 x 4 wood installation procedures!




Step 2

Sleeve 4 x 4-vinyl post over wood post. Vinyl post should be 1" longer than the wood post. If using post trim, place the trim over post now.



Step 3


Measure the span railing section will cover. Cut vinyl rails to fit this dimension. NOTE: Cut rails equal distance from each end so picket spacing is maintained. If galvanized insert is cut be sure to regalvanize edge to prevent rusting!



Step 4


Assemble railing section. (See Detail 1)


Place the pickets in the bottom rail, then angle the top rail and maneuver each picket in place.



Detail 1:


Slide brackets over rail, then install assembled railing section between posts making sure bottom rail is less than 2" from deck surface. **Note**: Place 1-15/16" support under the bottom rail on each end to locate the bracket at the proper height. Attach and secure brackets through vinyl post to wood using #10x2" stainless screws. Make sure assembled section is level and plumb before securing. (Top rail first!).





Secure rail and rail insert to bracket with #8 x 3/4" stainless screws.

Step 5



Stair Rail

When going down stairs, use stair rail sections and stair brackets. (Brackets are made to accept 32° angle)

Place vinyl cap on post. Secure cap with vinyl glue.
